

Brigitte Gedek Science Award for Mycotoxin Research

The **Society for Mycotoxin Research** is pleased to call for nominations for the **Brigitte Gedek Science Award 2025**.

The Brigitte Gedek Science Award is given by the Society for Mycotoxin Research for outstanding scientific achievements in the area of mycotoxin research, with the generous support from the Brigitte and Wolfram Gedek Foundation, Munich (Germany). The intention of the award is to recognize an individual researcher for a specific, outstanding work in the field of mycotoxin research (for example, doctorate/PhD thesis, habilitation, or a scientific article published in a peer-reviewed journal). Please note that in case of multi-author publications, only the first author of the publication will be awarded.

The award is endowed with **10,000 Euro**.

The Brigitte Gedek Science Award will be awarded during the **46th Mycotoxin Workshop in Martina Franca, Italy, May 25-28, 2025** (<https://www.mycotoxin-workshop.eu>).

The following documents are required for the application, which **must be made by a member of the Society for Mycotoxin Research** (unsolicited applications or self applications will not be considered).

- Letter of recommendation, signed by a member of the Society for Mycotoxin Research
- A curriculum vitae of the nominated candidate
- A brief summary of the specific scientific work (English and German language, one page each)
- The publication (thesis, scientific publication)
